Habitat for Humanity of Weber and Davis Counties will be holding a **Yard Sale** on **February 19 and 20, 2010**. The sale will take place indoors at the former Foods Etc. store at Clearfield Towne Square, located near State Street and 200 South in Clearfield (look for our signs).

We will be selling **surplus building materials, new and used furniture, appliances, tools, sporting goods, toys, and other household and yard care items (no clothes)**. All proceeds from this two-day event will directly help to support our next construction projects for two new family partners.

During this event, there are four ways you can support Habitat's mission to help low-income families build and buy their own simple, decent, safe, and affordable homes: 1) **donate** items for the yard sale; 2) **volunteer** your time to help during the yard sale; 3) **shop** the sale; and 4) **tell or bring a friend**. This is a great opportunity to clean out your garage, closet, storage shed, or basement, and your **donations are tax-deductible!** If you are a homeowner, it's also a terrific time to find some real bargains on supplies for your next home improvement project.
